1. PROJECT MANAGEMENT: Human Settlements Expert and Deputy Task Team Leader. The Human Settlements Expert plays a key role in the conceptualization, planning, and implementation of LSIP at the national, city, and settlement levels. Together with the international Human Settlements Expert (Task Team Leader), the Consultant will work closely with all consultants to guide the loan processing and ensure coordination, consistency, and high quality in delivery of shared and individual project tasks. The consultant should be an Indonesian national with a minimum 5 years of experience in planning and implementing development projects in the urban sector. S/he should have in-depth knowledge of local government administrative structures, working procedures, and coordination mechanisms for urban development, and excellent written and oral communications skills in both Indonesian and English.

The Youth Researcher is one of two youth consultants who will implement a pilot project to develop youth-led analytical tools to measure multiple dimensions of poverty and vulnerability as experienced by young people in informal settlement areas and other vulnerable environments in Cirebon. The knowledge generated from the pilot aims to complement the processing of LSIP and provide a methodology for similar approaches to youth-led research that could influence city planning across the country and region. The consultant should be an Indonesian national, between 22 and 29 years of age and based in Cirebon. The consultant should have demonstrated experience in designing surveys to facilitate data collection using rigorous approaches, conducting both field and desk investigation for development projects in Indonesia; and designing and implementing specific capacity building initiatives for youth. The consultant will have strong proficiency in Indonesian and working proficiency in English.
